
Tommy started his career with the Carrollton Police Department in 1973 at a starting salary of \$500/month. He graduated from the police academy in 1974 which consisted of 114 hours of training. He was promoted to Corporal in December 1975 and to Sergeant in June 1976. He achieved the rank of Lt. Detective in June 1977. Throughout his career he sought out advanced training. He attended the State of Georgia DEA School, as well as advanced training in criminal investigation, fingerprinting, and crime scene investigation – always sharing his knowledge with his fellow officers.

He was instrumental in establishing the Carrollton Fraternal Order of Police, Tony Jackson Garrett, Lodge # 35. It was started, in part, because there was little interaction between shifts and "we needed brotherhood and sisterhood". It is because of his willingness to give his time and energy to something he felt was important that we have the successful lodge of today. Chartered April 23rd, 1975, we currently have 314 regular members plus 16 associate members. The lodge is named after Tony Jackson Garrett, Tommy's close friend, who was killed in a car crash in the line of duty - Christmas 1975.

THE CAPTAIN OF UNIFORM SERVICES IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DAY-TO-DAY OPERATIONS OF THE UNIFORM SERVICES DIVISION, WHICH INCLUDES PATROL, TRAFFIC, COPS UNIT, K-9 TEAMS, CRISIS RESPONSE UNIT, AND THE OFFICERS. THE UNIFORM SERVICES CAPTAIN PLANS, DIRECTS AND COORDINATES THE DEPARTMENT'S UNIFORMED OFFICERS IN LAW ENFORCEMENT PATROL OPERATIONS. SOME OF THE PATROL CAPTAIN'S PRIMARY FUNCTIONS ARE TO PROVIDE OVERALL LEADERSHIP AND VISION TO THE UNIFORM DIVISION, ENSURE THAT OFFICERS ARE PROPERLY EQUIPPED AND TRAINED, MANAGE THE FLEET OF PATROL VEHICLES, REVIEW USE OF FORCE & VEHICLE PURSUIT REPORTS, AND TO EVALUATE AND CREATE POLICY & PROCEDURES THAT BEST MANAGES AND ADVANCES THE MISSION OF THE CARROLLTON POLICE DEPARTMENT.

Captain Cole was assigned to C-Shift until 2012, where he served as an Officer, Corporal, and Sergeant. He then moved to the Criminal Investigation Division and served as a Detective until 2016. He returned to the Uniform Division as a Lieutenant and was promoted to Captain in 2017. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Criminology from UWG and has achieved 3,957 hours of POST training.



# UNIFORM SERVICES

THE UNIFORM DIVISION LIEUTENANTS ARE ESSENTIAL TO THE MISSION AND VISION OF THE CARROLLTON POLICE DEPARTMENT. THEY PROVIDE LEADERSHIP BY WORKING TO MAINTAIN COHESION BETWEEN THE VARIOUS PATROL SHIFTS AND SPECIALIZED UNITS WITHIN THE DIVISION. 

TRAFFIC UNIT

The Traffic Unit's primary role is to maintain the safety of motorists and pedestrians traveling within the City of Carrollton. The unit investigates over two thousand motor vehicle collisions a year. These range from minor fender benders to serious and fatal accidents. They also investigate the hundreds of hit and run accidents that occur. The Traffic Unit utilizes various speed detection technologies to examine areas of citizen complaints and to enforce speed limits throughout the city. The unit is also responsible for traffic control and roadway closures for the city's special events such as the Fourth of July Parade and Fireworks, Mayfest, and the Taste of Carrollton.

The Motorcycle Unit operates within the Traffic Unit. It was established in May of 2004, and it is comprised of four motor units, predominantly functioning within daylight hours. The purpose of the Motorcycle Unit was to provide more agility in heavy traffic to enforce Georgia traffic law while being visible in the community. The Motor Unit also participates in special details such as funeral escorts and leading the Fourth of July Parade.

# CALLS FOR SERVICE

The Carrollton Police Department responded to more than 43,703 calls for service in 2023. This represents an increase of 14.24% over the more than 38,256 calls in 2022. Officers made 1,923 arrests in 2023 versus 1,834 in 2022. This represents a 5% increase in arrests for the department. There were 63 use of force incidents in 2023. That is a decrease of 32% when compared to 2022, and a 39% decrease in incidents when compared to 2021.

Use of force data shows that in 2023, the department was required to use force on black males slightly more than white males. 58 % of all subjects arrested in use of force incidents were Black, and 41 % White. 82 % were males and 18 % females.


Each use of force is reviewed by multiple levels of supervisors and command staff. During 2023, there were 0 use of force incidents that were found to be in violation of department policy.

Since 2021, there has been a continued decrease in the amount of times that force was used. These incidents decreased at a rate of 39 % within 3 years. Violations of department policy will continue to be addressed with discipline and additional training. An extensive analysis will continue to be conducted in the upcoming years to detect any emerging trends.

THE COPS UNIT, OPERATING ON BOTH SPECIALLY EQUIPPED BICYCLES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES, ALLOWS THE BIKE UNIT TO PATROL AREAS WHICH MAY BE EITHER DIFFICULT TO PATROL OR OTHERWISE INACCESSIBLE VIA A STANDARD POLICE CRUISER, ADDITIONALLY, THE UNIT CAN USE THE ADVANTAGES OF STEALTH TO INCREASE ITS ABILITY TO LOCATE AND APPREHEND CRIMINALS. THE COPS UNIT CAN BE SEEN THROUGHOUT THE CITY—EITHER ON ADAMSON SQUARE, VARIOUS SHOPPING CENTERS, PARKS, NEIGHBORHOODS, AND MOST RECENTLY THE CARROLLTON GREENBELT. THE CARROLLTON GREENBELT IS AN APPROXIMATELY 18 MILE PAVED MULTI-USE TRAIL SYSTEM WHICH LOOPS AROUND THE CITY, CONNECTING KEY LOCATIONS. IT IS THE LARGEST PAVED TRAIL LOOP IN THE STATE OF GEORGIA AND THE COPS UNIT TAKES GREAT PRIDE IN WORKING TO KEEP IT SAFE FOR EVERYONE TO ENJOY.

During the year 2020, the COPS Unit was able to organize and participate in well over 200 community centered programs and projects. SOME OF THESE PROGRAMS INCLUDE COOL CONVERSATIONS, COFFEE WITH A COP, CHILD SAFETY SEAT CHECKS, GOVERNMENT AND LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTERED TASK FORCES, LAW ENFORCEMENT EDUCATION PROGRAMS, SOCIAL JUSTICE PARADES AND MARCHES, AND MORE. THE COPS UNIT SERVES AS THE PROACTIVE VEHICLE FOR COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND PARTNERSHIP WITHIN OUR DEPARTMENT, WHILE ALSO PROVIDING TRADITIONAL POLICING SERVICES TO FURTHER ASSIST THE CARROLLTON COMMUNITY AT LARGE. NEAR THE END OF 2020, THIS UNIT BEGAN DEVELOPING THE FOUNDATION FOR A CARROLL County wide Community Policing task force which will serve as another steppingstone for law enforcement officers in building ENGAGEMENT AND TRUST WITHIN THE COMMUNITIES THEY SERVE.

WITH THE INCLUSION OF THE POLICE OFFICER AND PARAMEDIC ON THE NEW CARROLL COUNTY CRISIS RESPONSE TEAM, THE GOAL IS A SOFTER APPROACH TO EFFECTIVELY DEAL WITH PEOPLE WHO ARE HAVING A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS.


THOMASSON IS PAIRED WITH A LICENSED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR WHOSE JOB INCLUDES ATTEMPTING TO CALM THE PERSON, AS WELL AS, TO IMMEDIATELY NAVIGATE THE MANY LEGAL AND HEALTHCARE CHALLENGES TO GETTING THE PERSON THE HELP THEY NEED. IT STARTS WITH THE 911 CALL WHERE THE DISPATCHER IDENTIFIES THE SITUATION AS A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS. THE MOBILE CRISIS RESPONSE UNIT WILL BE DISPATCHED IN A PLAIN WHITE SUV, THAT WILL HAVE UNDERCOVER LIGHTS AND SIRENS IF NEEDED.

MAYOR BETTY CASON SAYS MENTAL HEALTH CALLS CAN BE BOTH DANGEROUS AND EXPENSIVE FOR EVERYONE INVOLVED AND CAN OFTEN END WITH THE PATIENT NOT GETTING THE HELP THEY DESPERATELY NEEDED. CITIES ACROSS THE COUNTRY DEBATE THE PROPER LAW ENFORCEMENT RESPONSE TO MENTAL HEALTH CALLS THAT CAN LEAD TO DEATH, INJURY, AND ARREST. CARROLL COUNTY'S PROGRAM IS AN OVERALL EFFORT ON THE PART OF THE COURTS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT THAT DATES TO 2008.

# LICENSE PLATE READER

License plate readers (LPR) are high-speed, computer-controlled camera systems that are typically mounted on street poles, streetlights, highway overpasses, mobile trailers, or attached to police squad cars. LPR's automatically captures all license plate numbers that come into view, along with the location, date, and time. The data, which includes photographs of the vehicle and sometimes its driver and passengers is then uploaded to a central server.

### Mission Statement

The mission of the Carrollton Police Department's School Resource Officer is to create and maintain a safe and secure environment by supporting the functions of teaching and learning within the school system. We will build positive relationships with the students and staff by proactively interacting with the school community.

Duties and Responsibilities of the School Resource Officer:

- The primary duty is to provide a safe and secure learning environment for students and staff at all Carrollton City School Campuses.
- The SRO will assist the school administration in developing plans and strategies to prevent and/or minimize dangerous incidents that may occur on campus. SRO's will interact with students and build positive relationships.
- The SRO when requested will attend conferences with teachers, parents, and students.
- The SRO will patrol their school to maintain a safe environment, protect life, and prevent loss or destruction of property.
- The SRO will respond to and investigate criminal occurrences at their school.
- The SRO is involved in teaching B.A.D.G.E. (Bullying, Attitude, Drugs, Gangs, Education).



# SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS

The school crossing guards specialize in the control of vehicle and pedestrian traffic at school crossings. Their job is to prevent accidents and protect the safety of school children and other pedestrians. A school crossing guard does not have the authority to arrest but does have the power to perform traffic control operations for the safe flow of vehicles and movement of pedestrians. They may appear in court against violators. A School Crossing Guard is a part time position. Their work is performed during particular hours of the day, depending on crossing, and is performed within well—defined procedures and regulations. Their work is checked by police officers by spot inspection and by review of records of injuries at crossings. The School Crossing Guards are under the supervision of the special operations Lieutenant and assist at various events where traffic control is needed such as football games, school functions, or community events.

## POLICE HONOR GUARD

THE CARROLLTON POLICE DEPARTMENT HONOR GUARD IS COMPRISED OF OFFICERS WHO VOLUNTEER THEIR TIME TO WORK SPECIAL FUNCTIONS. THE HONOR GUARD TRAINS IN DRILL AND CEREMONY AND PROVIDES ITS SERVICES TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE COMMUNITY. HONOR GUARD FUNCTIONS INCLUDE FUNERAL DETAILS, BRINGING IN THE COLORS (UNITED STATES AND GEORGIA FLAGS) IN VARIOUS CEREMONIES AND OTHER SPECIAL DETAILS.



We have a pool of General Investigators who work diligently to identify, apprehend, and successfully prosecute offenders. POSITIVE WORKING RELATIONSHIPS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED WITH NUMEROUS AGENCIES, REPRESENTATIVES, AND COMMUNITY CONSTITUENTS TO ACCOMPLISH THIS GOAL. TECHNICAL AND FISCAL RESOURCES HAVE BEEN ALLOTTED TO THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION DIVISION IN AN EFFORT TO SUPPORT THE EVER GROWING NEEDS AND CHANGES OF OUR COMMUNITY.

It is the responsibility of the Criminal Investigative Division to investigate incidents. This Division collects AND ORGANIZES FACTS AND EVIDENCE THAT LEADS TO THE IDENTIFICATION, APPREHENSION, AND SUCCESSFUL PROSECUTION OF THE OFFENDER. THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE SERVICES DIVISION IS COMPRISED OF FIVE LAW ENFORCEMENT UNITS: GENERAL INVESTIGATIONS, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, IDENTIFICATION/EVIDENCE, ACE UNIT, AND CRIME ANALYST. THE CARROLLTON POLICE DEPARTMENT'S CYBERCRIME UNIT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR INVESTIGATING AND COMBATING CRIMES COMMITTED USING TECHNOLOGY AND THE INTERNET. THIS INCLUDES A RANGE OF OFFENSES SUCH AS IDENTITY THEFT, ONLINE FRAUD, CHILD EXPLOITATION, AND CYBERBULLYING. THE UNIT USES A VARIETY OF TOOLS AND TECHNIQUES TO IDENTIFY AND TRACK DOWN OFFENDERS, INCLUDING FORENSIC ANALYSIS OF DIGITAL DEVICES AND ONLINE SURVEILLANCE. THEY ALSO WORK CLOSELY WITH OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AND PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS TO SHARE INFORMATION AND COORDINATE INVESTIGATIONS. OVERALL, THE GOAL OF THE CYBER CRIME UNIT IS TO PROTECT THE COMMUNITY FROM THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF CYBERCRIME AND HOLD THOSE RESPONSIBLE ACCOUNTABLE FOR THEIR ACTIONS.

THIS UNIT CONSISTS OF FOUR DETECTIVES: LT. BLAKE HITCHCOCK, CPL. SETH DENNEY, CPL. BRANDON WILSON, AND CPL. Glenn Lyle who have a combined 90 years of law enforcement experience.

The Cybercrime unit analyzes, on average, about 200 devices a year. These devices include cell phones, hard DRIVES, MEMORY CARDS, THUMB DRIVES, DRONES, DVR SYSTEMS AND VEHICLE INFOTAINMENT SYSTEMS. EACH DETECTIVE IS A MEMBER OF THE ICAC (INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN) TASK FORCE AND ONE DETECTIVE IS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE CYBER FRAUD TASK FORCE. THIS ALLOWS THE DETECTIVES TO ASSIST OTHER AGENCIES WITH EXAMINATION OF DIGITAL EVIDENCE AS WELL AS OBTAINING ADDITIONAL FUNDS AND TRAINING FOR OUR UNIT.

The ACE Unit, under the supervision of Lt. Chad Taylor, is comprised of investigators who are responsible for the suppression of drug activity, organized crime activity, and vice activity by initiating and investigating any cases of these activities as well as assist the General Investigators as necessary. These officers also serve as the control investigator for confidential informants. They must properly document all contact with informants and supply the appropriate information to the Captain of the Criminal Investigation Division. This Unit is also responsible for seeking out information regarding the local drug trade, gang activity, and/or assisting other law enforcement agencies. Each of these officers are assigned to a seven-day on-call rotation.

# SPECIAL RESPONSE TEAM

The Carrollton Special Response Team (S.R.T.) is comprised of 25 members from throughout the police department who are trained and skilled to perform in high-stress situations. In addition to the officers, there are several Carrollton firefighters who serve as tactical medics on the team. S.R.T. specializes in executing "high-risk" search warrants, which usually stem from investigations into narcotic sales and criminal street gang activity. Additionally, the S.R.T. is charged with responding to critical incidents that occur inside the City of Carrollton, such as "barricaded gummen" and "hostage situations". The team trains together twice a month, with a focus on various forms of building entry & clearing, vehicle take-downs, and firearm skills. They are equipped with advanced armor, tools, and equipment that enable them to perform their operations and missions safely and efficiently. Team members volunteer to serve, and they are selected based on their experience and ability to perform at a high level.




### CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN

The Department joined the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force in 2006. Detectives in the Criminal Investigation Division participate in activities of the Task Force which include the investigation of possession, distribution, or manufacturing of child pornography images on a computer or using the internet to entice children for sexual or indecent purposes. In addition, detectives teach classes for children and adults to educate them about internet safety.

### **NALOXONE**

In 2016, the Carrollton Police Department received Naloxone kits. Naloxone is a medication designed to rapidly reverse opioid overdose. It is an opioid antagonist—meaning that it binds to opioid receptors and can reverse and block the effects of other opioids. It can very quickly restore normal respiration to a person whose breathing has slowed or stopped because of over-dosing with heroin or prescription opioid pain medications. Addicts are not the only people who experience accidental overdoses. Elderly and children may take too much medication or the wrong medication by accident. When given intravenously, naloxone works within two minutes, and when injected into a muscle, it works within five minutes; it may also be sprayed into the nose. The effects of naloxone last about half an hour to an hour. Multiple doses may be required as the duration of action of most opioids is greater than that of naloxone.





### **SHOTSPOTTER**

The University of West Georgia Police Department implemented a system known as ShotSpotter. Installation of the system is a result of Operation Protect our Pack; the collaborative effort among UPD and community law enforcement agencies launched in 2017. This system is gunshot detection technology that uses sophisticated acoustic sensors to detect, locate and alert law enforcement agencies about illegal gunfire incidents in real-time. This empowers authorities to respond faster and more safely. The Carrollton Police Department officers have been granted access to the secure ShotSpotter phone application which notifies users when a live round has been fired in their jurisdiction. The technology uses audio sensors placed atop buildings to triangulate the sound of gunfire. ShotSpotter trained acoustic experts review and qualify all gunfire incidents and alert law enforcement immediately, all within a minute, and usually within 30 seconds, of the gunshot occurring. The system can also determine the difference between similar sounds, like fireworks or an engine backfire, thus saving valuable resources. The ShotSpotter system will have a direct effect on making our areas safer.



The investigation of crime and the prosecution of offenders requires that information be obtained through the application of scientific knowledge and methods. To effectively use laboratory support services, physical evidence must be identified, collected, preserved properly, and transmitted to the laboratory. Physical evidence is of major importance in all cases, particularly in those cases that have no witnesses. The successful prosecution of a case often depends on the quality of the physical evidence that is collected and the manner in which it is presented.

Our evidence building allows us more space on the forensic side for processing items for latent evidence through different chemical processes, i.e. Cyanoacrylate Fuming (super glue). Our lab offers a vented hood for chemical processes like Ninhydrin. A Cyanoacrylate Fuming Chamber allows us to fume without breathing hazardous fumes. A bullet trap allows us to fire rounds safely to collect shell casings to be sent to the ATF for entry into NIBIN (National Integrated Ballistic Information Network). The lab is also used for the weighing of controlled substances, macro photography used in latent processing, and a down flow hood used to dust items for prints.



# LATENT PRINTS

THE CARROLLTON POLICE DEPARTMENT HAS A CERTIFIED LATENT PRINT EXAMINER. THE DEPARTMENT USES THE ULW SOFTWARE PROVIDED BY THE FBI THAT SEARCHES THE NGI DATABASE THAT IS MAINTAINED BY THE FBI TO SEARCH UNKNOWN LATENT PRINTS FOR IDENTIFICATION. THE DEPARTMENT HAS ADDED ADDITIONAL SOFTWARE FOR SEARCHING LATENT PRINTS. THE NEW SOFTWARE, AFIX TRACKER, IS A DATABASE THAT OUR AGENCY MAINTAINS. THE OFFENDER DATABASE IS UPDATED DAILY FROM THE LIVE SCAN AT THE CARROLL COUNTY JAIL. THE DATABASE CURRENTLY HOUSES 57,513 IMPRESSION FILES.

THE DEPARTMENT PROCESSES EVIDENCE USING VARIOUS METHODS FOR THE PRESENCE OF LATENT PRINTS. NINHYDRIN, CYANOACRYLATE FUMING, AND POWDERS ARE SOME OF THE MORE COMMON. AN ALTERNATE LIGHT SOURCE IS USED IN PHOTOGRAPHY TO CAPTURE SOME OF THESE DEVELOPED LATENT PRINTS.

THE DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN ASSISTING SURROUNDING DEPARTMENTS IN LATENT PRINT IDENTIFICATION. SEVERAL AGENCIES HAVE BEEN ABLE TO MAKE AN ARREST IN CASES, WITH OUR ASSISTANCE, WITH THE IDENTIFICATION OF LATENT PRINTS.

The Department, having the ability to work its own latent cases, dramatically decreases the time for the cases to be analyzed. This, in return, prevents crime by identifying a suspect quickly. In 2023, a total of 180 items were processed for the presence of latent prints. 148 impressions were developed with 94 of these being of quality for comparison purposes and 44 identifications were made from those developed. The Carrollton Police Department worked 58 cases related to latent prints with 45 of those being local cases and 13 of those assisting other agencies.

### COURT SERVICES

THE COURT SERVICES UNIT IS COMPRISED OF THREE FULL-TIME CLERKS, FOUR FULL-TIME ASSISTANT CLERKS, TWO PART-TIME EMPLOYEES, THE TERMINAL AGENCY COORDINATOR, THE COURT SUPERVISOR, THE SOLICITOR AND TWO JUDGES.

The Municipal Court of Carrollton process, hears, and adjudicates traffic citations, DUIs, city ordinance violations, limited misdemeanors that occurred within the city limits, parking tickets, code enforcement violations, and photo-enforced school bus violations.

The clerks work closely with the Solicitor, Prosecutor, and Judges, who are appointed by the Mayor and City Council. The court clerk duties include, but are not limited to, setting the court calendar, the safe keeping of all paperwork necessary for prosecution of cases, storage of records needed, and reporting those cases to the Georgia Department of Driver Service and GCIC. The court clerks also coordinate with CSRA Probation.

Assistant court clerks' responsibilities include answering incoming calls, accepting fine payments, processing bonds, and managing requests from the public about their criminal histories.

THE TERMINAL AGENCY COORDINATOR OVERSEES ALL GCIC TRAINING FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AS WELL AS ALL WARRANT ENTRIES, OTHER GCIC ENTRIES, AND RECORD RESTRICTIONS.

### **CHAPLAINCY**

The Police Chaplain is another important segment of Community Policing, acting as a liaison between the department, the officers, and their families. The duties of the police chaplain include ministering to officers and their families in times of injury, illness, or death; counseling officers and family members with problems they may be experiencing; offering instruction in stress management, ethics, death and dying; assisting in death notification or suicide incidents, victim assistance, and being on call for situations such as disasters, hostage negotiations, accidents, etc. and to provide support to officers as well as citizens. In March 2009, the Carrollton Police Department was able to expand the Chaplaincy program from one volunteer Chaplain to utilizing the services of five (5) volunteer Chaplains. Our current chaplains are: Vincent Dortch, Doug Hardy, Lee Wimberly, Caryl Strange, and Kellie Roberts.


# Youth Police Academy

The participants are introduced to being a concerned and active community member. The youth's exposure ranges from B.A.D.G.E. and school violence to crime scene investigation. # **2024 GOALS**

# TO IMPLEMENT A REAL TIME CRIME CENTER UTILIZING FLOCK OS

In 2023, the Carrollton Police Department was awarded a public safety & community violence reduction grant from the State of Georgia and was authorized to make purchases with the funds on 12.01.2023. To maximize the use of the funds, successfully enhance public safety, and reduce violence, a decision was made to purchase FlockOS through Flock Safety. FlockOS seamlessly integrates first and third-party data across video, license plate readers, and audio to deliver real-time intelligence and retroactive crime solving with unmatched scalability. This will enhance situational awareness and operational efficiency by layering all our intelligence streams into a Map system within FlockOS.

THE CARROLLTON POLICE DEPARTMENT IS CURRENTLY INTEGRATING THE ABOVE RESOURCES TO CREATE A PART-TIME REAL TIME CRIME CENTER WHICH IS BEING STAFFED BY TWO CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES WITHIN THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION DIVISION. ALL OFFICERS WILL HAVE ACCESS TO LIVE AND RECORDED FOOTAGE FROM ALL GOVERNMENT OWNED VIDEO SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS AS WELL AS ANY PRIVATE CAMERAS FROM BUSINESSES, HOUSES, AND APARTMENT COMPLEXES THAT ALLOW ACCESS TO THEIR FOOTAGE. THE COMMUNITY WILL BE ABLE TO REGISTER THEIR CAMERAS INTO OUR NEW CAMERA REGISTRY SO OFFICERS AND INVESTIGATORS WILL KNOW WHERE TO COLLECT VITAL VIDEO EVIDENCE TO ASSIST WITH CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS AND VEHICLE CRASHES. THE COMMUNITY PROGRAM WILL ALSO ALLOW COMMUNITY MEMBERS TO PURCHASE VARIOUS CAMERAS THAT CAN BE CONNECTED TO US. WE ARE CALLING THIS NEW PROGRAM THE "CARROLLTON COMMUNITY CAMERA PARTNERSHIP".

These measures will help the Carrollton Police Department be more proactive in preventing crime and have better access to all resources to investigate crime and vehicle crashes. This will further help us complete our mission of partnering with citizens to create a safe and responsible community.

# To implement a National Ballistics Information Network System (NIBIN)

NIBIN IS A CRITICAL PART OF ATF'S CRIME GUN INTELLIGENCE CENTER (CGIC) OPERATIONS. CGICS ARE MULTIAGENCY LAW ENFORCEMENT COLLABORATIONS FOCUSED ON STOPPING GUN CRIMES BY COLLECTING, ANALYZING, AND DISTRIBUTING INTELLIGENCE REPORTS ABOUT CRIME GUNS, MASS SHOOTINGS, AND MAJOR INCIDENTS ACROSS JURISDICTIONS. NIBIN TECHNOLOGY COMPARES IMAGES OF SUBMITTED BALLISTIC EVIDENCE FROM SHOOTING SCENES AND RECOVERED FIREARMS AND PRODUCES A LIST OF POSSIBLE SIMILAR RESULTS. TRAINED NIBIN TECHNICIANS THEN CONDUCT A CORRELATION REVIEW OF THESE RESULTS, IDENTIFYING NIBIN LEADS OR POTENTIAL LINKS OR ASSOCIATIONS FROM THE SAME FIREARM. A NIBIN LEAD IS AN UNCONFIRMED, POTENTIAL ASSOCIATION BETWEEN TWO OR MORE PIECES OF FIREARM BALLISTIC EVIDENCE AND IS BASED ON A CORRELATION REVIEW OF THE DIGITAL IMAGES IN THE NIBIN DATABASE.

WE WILL BE RECEIVING OUR EQUIPMENT AND GOING THROUGH THE TRAINING TO BE AN SITE ACQUISITION CENTER FOR SIX MONTHS TO A YEAR BEFORE GOING THROUGH MORE TRAINING TO PERFORM CORRELATIONS ON SITE.

# To pass our State Certification assessment and remain a State Certified Agency

In order to retain State Certification status, the Carrollton Police Department continuously monitors and updates its Standard Operating Procedures. Documentation is gathered every year to show compliance with 140 professional, industry standards. The documentation and standard operating procedures are verified, in person, every three years by State Certification Assessors during an "On-site Assessment." Attaining Certification status represents a significant professional achievement for a law enforcement agency and acknowledges the use of policies and procedures that are conceptually sound and operationally effective. The Certification Program provides a comprehensive blueprint for effective, professional law enforcement.
